Financial Agreement
2009-2010

1) Registration

This *non-refundable* annual fee is due at the time of re-registration for present students and at the time of application for all new students. If a new student is denied admittance by the school, \$200.00 of the fee will be refunded. Re-registering families may receive the discounted fee if *all* re-registration documentation and payment are *received* by the close of business on January 30, 2009.

2) Tuition (Book Usage Fees Included – *this saves you an average of \$700.00 per student!*)

Tuition is paid directly to the ECS Business Office. You may choose to pay annually or monthly. There are three methods of payment: cash/check, credit card, or direct debit/EFT. If paying monthly, you will make 11 payments, beginning in July. Payments are due by the 5th of each month and are delinquent after the 20th of the month. If you choose to have your payment direct debited, the payment will be debited on the 20th of the month. Direct Debits/EFTs are considered late if returned unpaid and will be handled as a returned check. Withdrawn students will be charged for consumable, damaged, and unreturned textbooks (see Parent/Student Handbook for more information). Tuition rates are as follows:

3) Multiple Child Tuition Discounts

Full tuition is paid on the child in the highest grade. An 8% discount is given on tuition to the 2nd and 3rd child of the same family. Any additional children of the same family receive a 45% discount on tuition.

4) Financial Aid

ECS accepts Florida P.R.I.D.E. Scholarships, log on at www.floridapride.org and find out more information. Financial Aid is available for those families who apply and qualify according to the financial aid guidelines. Once you have completed the ECS registration package and paid your fees, you may apply online at www.ffna1.com or pick up an FFNA application in the ECS Admissions Office and mail it directly to Family Financial Needs Assessment.

5) Financial Obligations

Accounts must be current for a student to attend classes, take exams (including finals), receive a report card, participate in their graduation ceremony, have records released and transcripts mailed. Once an account becomes 30 days delinquent, the student is subject to dismissal from enrollment at ECS. Upon withdrawal or dismissal, the student's records (except medical) will be held until all financial obligations are paid. No deductions or refunds of tuition payable or paid as required in this AGREEMENT will be made for withdrawal, absence, or dismissal after July 20, 2009. Prior to July 20, 2009, withdrawal is permitted without tuition penalty, otherwise a penalty will apply. Please see the Parent/Student Handbook for more information.

6) Late/Returned Check Fees

A late fee of \$30.00 will be applied to any account more than fifteen (15) days past the due date. Accounts with payments (checks, ETFs, etc.) returned by a financial institution for any reason will incur a charge of \$30.00 per returned transaction.

7) Activity & Technology Fee - \$200.00 per Student.

This *non-refundable* fee is billed on the July 2009 statement and is due with the August 2009 statement.

8) Parent Service Hours

Parents are required to assist the school for 10 hours *per student* during the school year. If a student's parents do not serve by April 30th, the student's account will be billed \$200.00 per student on the May billing. Please see the Parent/Student Handbook for more information.

9) Additional Fees

The following are fees students may incur, but are not limited to:

Transportation: ECS provides bus service to areas throughout Lee and Collier Counties. With the high cost of transportation and fuel, we are working to keep the cost down. All prices listed are based on monthly payments (September-May) and are to be paid one month in advance to the ECS Business Office. Student Transportation service is subject to the guidelines in the Transportation Manual and the Parent/Student Handbook.

Before and Aftercare: This service is for PK4 through 12th grade students of working parents only. It is available any day school is in session. Hours of operation are 6:30am to 8:00am and Dismissal to 6:00pm. On days when school is not in session, the program provides students PK4 through 6th grade with a "Day Camp" that allows parents to continue their regular routine. This program is open only to students who are enrolled full-time at ECS. Closing time is 6:00pm sharp. A \$15.00 fee is charged per student for each fifteen minutes or fractional part thereof after 6:00pm.

Graduation Fees: These fees are billed at the beginning of the school year and must be paid prior to school starting: K5 - \$35.00 and 12th grade – \$180.00 (does not include announcements).

Athletic Fees: *There is no participation fee for any sport a student plays!* Varsity and JV Football players must pay an insurance fee of \$135.00 per player (this insurance is secondary to their personal policy) - NO player will be allowed to practice football until the insurance fee has been paid. Other sports may incur additional equipment/uniform costs as determined by that team’s coach – information will be sent home with the player when available.

Advanced Placement Courses: \$225.00 per subject. This fee covers about half of the cost of the college texts and materials needed for the course and the cost of the AP exam and any practice tests that are given. ECS pays the remainder of these costs.

Specialized Digital and Technology Classes: Each student taking any of these classes must purchase the college texts from ECS prior to starting the class.

Music Lessons: Please see Miss Richey for current rates. Billed in equal monthly installments.

Elective Art and After-school Art: Grades 7-12 pay a fee of \$50.00 when taking Art as an elective course. Please see Mrs. Anderson for current rates on After-school art.

Miscellaneous Fines: These include the following: gum fines (\$10.00 per occurrence), lost and found, library fines, discipline consequences, etc.

Parking Decals: Any 11th or 12th grade student wishing to drive to school must purchase a parking permit for their car at a cost of \$10.00. Student Parking privileges are subject to the guidelines in the Campus Vehicle Manual.

Senior Trip/10th Grade Missions Trip/8th Grade DC Trip/6th Grade Trip: The prices of these trips will be determined and information will be sent home when available.

Choir Uniforms: Students in 7th –12th grade who choose to participate in the ECS choir must use a uniform as specified by the choir director. Price will be determined and the information sent home when available.

Cheerleading Uniforms: Students who choose to participate in the Cheerleading program must purchase a uniform that the cheerleading advisor will order. Price will be determined and sent home when available.

This guaranty shall be unlimited; shall apply to any and all obligations of the Guarantor whether now existing or hereafter incurred; and shall inure to the benefit of EVANGELICAL CHRISTIAN SCHOOL, its successors and assigns.
