General Classroom supplies:

Hand sanitizer (1)
1 bag of individually sealed candy

SPANISH ELECTIVE- 1 composition book (black and white cover)

MATH NOTEBOOK- 200 or more pages, spiral bound, big enough to keep notes and complete assignments in for the whole year (120 Lessons). There will be a cumulative exam in math at the end of the year.

READING NOTEBOOK-A composition book or small spiral bound notebook Lee County Public Library card. We will be taking a field trip to

the library when the research paper gets close so students can get all their research done with their language teacher present. The library requires some form of ID to issue a student a card so go prepared with any ID you might have on hand.

HISTORY NOTEBOOK- 200 or more pages, spiral bound, big enough to keep notes and complete assignments in for the whole year. There will be a cumulative exam in History at the end of the year.

SCIENCE BINDER- 1", 3-ring binder (minimum, 1½" is also a good size) with at least 100 sheets of paper (college or wide ruled). This binder should have pockets in the front and back for temporary storage of take home quizzes.

LANGUAGE NOTEBOOK- either a 3-ring binder or a spiral bound notebook with at least 100 pages of paper

LANGUAGE COMPOSITION BOOK: bound black and white, wide ruled *My Side of the Mountain* by Jean Craighead George. Please put this book on hold at a local library or pick one up at a store. This will be the first book report of the year that students will start working on right away. If you like, you can even have students read this book over the summer (though that is certainly not required).
